\*Winter Guard has their first competition on January 25 at Greenwood. Their next competition for them is on February 1 at Danville.

\*Drum Line has their first competition on February 8 at Franklin Central. The Winter Guard and Drum Line state competition is on March 22. This is the same day as the Choir Festival that is to be held here at Plainfield High School. We are going to need volunteers for this festival because they helped us out at our festival and we promised to return the favor and help them in return.
