MULCH SALE:

- *Order forms are available.

- *We have approx \$4700.00 in the bank.
- *We will be able to accept credit cards at the concessions at our festival event in April.
- *Hopefully we will be able to get quick books, on a web based site, very soon.
- *By the end of May, we will have a short fall of \$6,000.00. This is why we need to really try to sell that mulch. We don't want to end a year in the red.

Tim Underwood:

*He has contacted 3 companies to invest in the rest of the discount cards. He will hopefully hear from them this week.

- *As a whole, our numbers will be up next year. We have 150 kids signed up for band next year.
- *We do have our gaming license now so we can hold raffles, etc.
- *We wanted to change our festival date in September but that date will not work. This means that our festival will be held on Sept. 13, 2014. Mark your calendars now.
- *We also need to find corporate sponsors for our band. This will help offset some of our costs. We will be able to put their names on the semi and even our show shirts.
- *The budget committee submitted the new budget for next to the board. They will be reviewing it then will brought before you in the next few months. We will be raising the band fees in the fall to \$325.00.
- *You will be receiving a letter from Tim Underwood in the next few days. Please read, sign and return to him as soon as you can. This letter pertains to the fact that the Disney trip is not a school sponsored trip any more and that all of the insurance and liability will be held with the travel company.
