

BAND BOOSTERS MEETING

August 18, 2015

Call to order: Harriet called the meeting to order at 7:32. Minutes were approved with one change to how scrip is spelled. Motion to approve was made by Jeff Ross and seconded by Margo Bryant.

Mr. Carpenter report: Important dates were listed on the board. From 3-5 on August 24, 2015 pictures will be taken of the band and the guard. Parents who can help fit the kids will be needed. If it is raining, then pictures will be on the following Monday, August 31.

Each semester the school does a fall fundraiser. If you sell 10 items you can earn a BOA ticket to the finals. We are again offering a \$100.00 buyout option for a ticket. Order forms will go out September 2, and are due September 16. Product delivery is the 30th and money will be due October 7. Products included are cheese, sausage, cookies etc. This fundraiser is separate from our booster fundraising committee.

Mr. Carpenter wanted to thank the people doing the truck remodel. It looks great. Uniform moms have been working hard. Show shirts look great too! Thanks to all!

Treasurer's report: We have \$13, 835.00 in checking and \$13801.00 in savings. Thanks to all who have paid their dues. He is going to send out statements next week. You can pay by check or credit card on line.

We budgeted for new plumes and they are on order.

Fundraising: Beverly said it takes other people helping with the fundraising to make it a success and she thanked them. We have four families who have ordered scrip and we have made \$196.00. Amy will have some ten dollar cards available after the booster meetings.

Plainfield had the most people signed up for the Street Beat 5 K. We also made \$200.00 from it. Trash bags forms will go out and be due September 4. We will charge \$10 per roll. She has some forms tonight. The turnaround time is a week. If we want to do this every other month that is an option. She will also have extra red spirit wear shirts and show shirts available and bags available after the meeting. If want something let her know. She might be able to get show shirts by Thursday. All other spirit wear will be in sometime in the next 2 weeks.

President report: If you were at the picnic we handed out proud band parent stickers. If you did not get one or want more see her. September 12 will be the first competition. It is in Fishers. Mr. Carpenter will put an itinerary together once we have the time of performance. Usually expect kids to be here 4-6 hours prior to competition time. We feed the kids before they get on the bus. Tina said we have people in all the key roles so we are in good shape. Fall break there is a football game, senior night and Evansville competition. So don't go far for Fall Break.
