Sept 12 Band Contest

The first contest of the marching band season is Sept 12 at Fishers High School on the NE side of Indy. (Use 13000 Promise Road, Fishers, IN 46038 for Google, Mapquest or GPS).

The band's itinerary was emailed out on September 7. If you did not receive this email, contact Teri Groechen. It lists the entire day in detail. The highlights are: students arrive at PHS @ 9:30 a.m. for rehearsal @ 10:00 a.m. -- rehearsal ends @ 12:50 p.m. - students eat lunch provided by Boosters -- depart for Fishers @ 2:30 p.m. -- PHS competes @ 6:15 p.m. -- students will stay to watch Class A bands and attend awards -- estimated arrival time back at PHS is 11:00 p.m.

We encourage parents to attend the event at the school; there is an admission charge at the gate of \$7 (student/seniors 65 & older are \$5). Wear your show shirt, find the PHS section and cheer on our band! (*Students must have a note and submit it to the bus chaperone if he/she is not riding home on the bus!*)
