THINGS TO KNOW:

Uniform

- 1. Respect the uniform always. They are brand new and represents our band and community. Never wear the uniform improperly. Many future generations of PHS band members will wear this uniform with Pride. Build that tradition!
- 2. Do not run in uniform.
- 3. Never touch the plumes.
- 4. You are required to wear your show shirt, black gym shorts, and plain long black socks under your uniform
- 5. Jewelry and nail polish are not permitted when in uniform.
- 6. Long hair must be secured into shako. Hair should not be covering your neck.

Bus

- 1. All bus rules apply.
- 2. Girls and boys/Couples will not be on a bus alone. No purple seats when traveling.
- 3. Leave the bus looking better than how we found it.
- 4. Chaperones will be placed throughout the bus for supervision. Be respectful of our chaperones.

Rules

- 1. All school rules apply to every member of the band with no exceptions.
- 2. Possession of alcohol, tobacco products, or drugs at any band function will result in immediate disciplinary action by Plainfield High School and can result in immediate dismal from band.

After We Perform

- 1. Change out of uniform and make sure everything is put away properly. Parents will monitor this process.
- 2. Watch other bands from the back stands. Clap for every band and be respectful.
- 3. Stay in groups of 4 or more.
