By signing this form, you are agreeing to be a part of the 2023-24 Plainfield High School Band Program. This includes:

- Being at all rehearsals and competitions;
- Obeying the Student Code of Conduct and all rules and guidelines set by the directors; and
- Timely payment of all marching band fees in accordance with the schedule.

If you have to miss rehearsal, you must notify one of the directors, **one week, in writing, in advance of an absence**. Calling the day of a rehearsal or performance is <u>not acceptable</u>.

## YOUR ATTENDANCE IS CRITICAL TO THE SUCCESS OF THE PROGRAM.

The 2023 Marching Band Fee of \$980 is payable in four payments. Your marching fees are allocated to staff, music, copyright fees, uniform, uniform accessories, medical supplies, vehicle rental, food, competition fees, awards, drill design, etc. The fee schedule is broken down as follows:

\$300 is due June 1st, \$240 is due July 1st, \$240 is due August 1st, & \$200 is due September 1st.

OR

\$196 is due June 1st, July 1st, August 1st, September 1st, and October 1st...

If fees are not current or different payment arrangements are not made by August 15, 2023 your student may be assigned an alternative performance spot on competition days.

If a student wants to participate in marching band, we don't want money to be an issue. We can make other scheduled payment arrangements, if needed. Please contact the treasurer to work out a different schedule that works for your family and the band family. We offer opportunities to earn money towards your student's band fees and contacting the school's Guidance Office is another possibility. If you fail to make arrangements and/or keep the arrangements made, your account will go to collections.

The Health Forms are due the first day of practice. This is not negotiable. This form is necessary for the safety of students if they need to be treated medically. The Commitment Form and Student Code of Conduct are due the first week of summer camp in June. This ensures we can communicate accurate numbers to the drill writer and music arranger.

By signing this document, you and your parents are agreeing to pay the Marching Band dues in accordance with the outlined payment schedule (or otherwise agreed upon payment terms). If for some reason you leave the program after signing this form, the dues must still be paid in full. It is the policy of the Booster Organization to not issue refunds of dues. Excess funds in your student's account may be donated to another band family or you may allow the Board to allocate those funds to needy families. You may appeal this policy with the Band Booster Board; however, their decision is final.
