We have new pizza cards. They gave us a check for \$450 for the mistake on the first ones.

On the Sugarfire fundraiser we earned \$4300. That will be divided by hours worked and credited to your individual accts.

Rita has volunteered to help post global payments. We have filed an extension for last years taxes so we need to get this wrapped up so we can close out our previous year.

The staff contracts have been drawn up and read by Elaine, Rita, and Mike multiple times. Mike mentioned that we are checking and double checking them before they are even presented to staff. Contracts will be signed by 4 people.

Mark asked if there is a variance in budgeted payroll and actual. Elaine said yes, we are under budget.

Elaine moved the money from the uniform savings acct and wrote the check to the school board treasurer to cover our portion of the new uniforms.

Concessions is closing. We will be updating ECA accts and totals as this is completed.

Elaine will be going out of town, will empty cash box tonight and then not again until she gets back in town the 21st. Rita will have the checkbook and cards.

Kimberly- Charms is locked up as we close out previous year to avoid confusion as kids advance.

Mike- March 7th IPA show. That is a very busy week so should fare well hoisting.

Mini camp is wrapping up. Friday around 6-6:30pm we will have a mini performance for the kids to show off a little bit of what they've been learning so far.

Kings Island is approved for Tuesday July 30th. School buses will leave at 8am and return around 11pm.

The kids are learning a lot at mini camp and doing very well.

Still waiting on approval of one of the pieces we'd like to use.

Melissa- Sign ups coming up will be relative to band camp- first aid, cool treats, frozen washcloths, etc.

Kona Ice confirmed for Wednesday July 24th at the end of camp, and for our first football game, which is youth appreciation night. They cut us a check for \$170 for the concert in the park.
